Taking Online Lessons

Here are a few tips for taking successful online lessons as well as some online etiquette to follow.

First of all, it is important to have a reliable, fast internet connection and a fully charged device. It is optimal to connect to the internet directly through an Ethernet cable rather

than use Wifi. Also, turning off the Wifi to other devices during the lesson time will give you the fastest connection.

Next, set your device on a table top or music stand about 6ft from the side of the piano. Point the camera down toward you and the keyboard so that both your face and the keyboard can be seen. You could even use

two devices, one on you and the other on the piano!

Make sure the room your lesson is held in is well lit. The best case is when your light source is facing you and your device is in front of that and facing you as well.

During your lesson put your phone on "Do

Not Disturb". Also, try to have as quiet an environment during this time as best you can.

Finally, have your lesson books, a pencil, a device to play a recording and a metronome ready to use.
