Repertoire Week

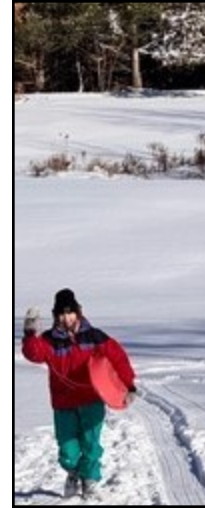

Best Audio For Zoom Desktop**Client:**

1. Sign in and start a Meeting.
 2. Click the Audio Icon
 3. Choose Audio Settings
 4. Go To Audio Profile
- Choose Original sound For Musicians
-Check high fidelity music mode, echo cancellation and stereo audio.

During Each Meeting:

Look in the upper left corner of your Screen. If you see "Original Sound For Musicians: Off" click on it to Turn it On!
